Padraic J. (“Pat”) Sweeney is a Senior International Trade Specialist in the International Trade Administration (ITA) of the U.S. Department of Commerce. Mr. Sweeney provides analysis and policy guidance for U.S. Government management and staff on international trade issues connected with agricultural equipment, including irrigation equipment, as well as other types of machinery and equipment used to grow, process, package, and prepare food products. He also supervises a team of analysts covering international trade in advanced manufacturing and industrial machinery. Mr. Sweeney works closely with private-sector organizations and frequently counsels U.S. manufacturers of agricultural equipment on international markets.

Mr. Sweeney also develops market intelligence on global markets for agricultural equipment, and is the author of the *2017 ITA Top Markets Report for Agricultural Equipment*.

Mr. Sweeney works with private- and public-sector groups around the country to support U.S. agricultural equipment manufacturers and exporters. Prior to his current position, Mr. Sweeney served as senior advisor to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Basic Industries, and in other ITA offices. Mr. Sweeney holds a Bachelor’s degree from George Mason University and a Master’s degree in International Affairs from Columbia University.
